Welcome to 84-Sports!! Let's get this Winter 2019 season started with practicing hard and inspiring your players to do great things! We're happy to provide a premiere facility that will help you do just that.



- Absolutely no gum, candy, tobacco pouches, cleats or drinks allowed on the turf. No "celebration" foods inside of the facility (donuts, cupcakes, cakes, etc). Please be a good example by honoring our House Rules.
- Be courteous and be on time for the start and end of your practices. Wrap up should begin 10 minutes prior to the end of your practice session. Meetings are welcomed to be held in the Southeast corner of the facility outside of the netted area. Cages will not be available space for meetings due to the high volume of cage rentals this season and the change in our cage policy.
- Parents and spectators are welcome during practice sessions. For safety reasons, children must be supervised at all times. Parents must be aware of cage policy and that cages are not to be used as playpens to confine children not participating in practices. Coaches/Assistants with children need to make arrangements for supervision of their children during practice sessions as well. We have experienced children using pitching mats as swings, writing on the aisle flooring with chalk, playing behind the Front Desk and darting outside into the parking lot unaware of moving vehicles. Let's keep our kids safe!! And please remind spectators to stay OFF and AWAY from the nets. Several spectators were injured last season when leaning into or walking too close to the nets. Remember there are live baseballs/softballs/soccerballs/lacrosse balls in play on the fields moving at rapid speeds! Always be alert and use caution!
- When expanding and collapsing the pullout tunnels on either field, it is our policy that 2 adults expand or collapse the tunnels. Should you need assistance, please see the Front Desk.
